

The evaluation committee will be constituted by the Maha-Metro to evaluate the Technical Proposals on the basis of their responsiveness to the provisions of bid document, applying the evaluation criteria. A Proposal shall be rejected at this stage if it does not respond to or all aspects of the Technical Proposal.
2. Financial Proposals of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened.

3. Tender Evaluation:

The agency will be selected based on the following method:

3.1 Stage-I: Technical evaluation of Proposals: (Maximum Marks=100) (Weightage 70%)

At the first stage, the technical proposal will be evaluated on the various grounds. Only those bidders whose technical proposal scores minimum **50 Marks** out of **100 Marks** shall be considered for opening of Financial Bid. The technical and financial evaluation will carry weightage of **@ 70% and 30%** respectively. Bidder shall be assigned different marks out of a total of 100 marks as per the criteria specified subsequently: -

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3.2 Breakup of Marks for Stage-I Evaluation

A. Average Annual Turnover (Last 3 Financial Year) (Marks-20)

Average annual turnover for the last three (03) audited financial years from **similar type of work** as per Financial Criteria given in Clause 3.3 of Section 3 (Eligibility Criteria):

1. Equal to or Above Rs. 14.86 Crores and up to Rs. 20 Crores **(10 marks)**
2. Above Rs. 20 Crores and up to Rs. 25 Crores **(12 marks)**
3. Above Rs. 25 Crores and up to Rs. 30 Crores **(15 marks)**
4. Above Rs. 30 Crores **(20 marks)**

B. Similar Completed Work Experience (Marks-20)

Similar Completed Work Experience in **single contract** during last 07(seven) years as per Minimum Eligibility Criteria given in Clause 3.2 of Section 3 (Eligibility Criteria):

1. Value of single completed contract above Rs. 5.94 Crores and up to Rs. 7.43 Crores **(10 marks)**
2. Value of single completed contract above Rs. 7.43 Crores and up to Rs. 11.89 Crores **(12 marks)**
3. Value of single completed contract above Rs. 11.89 Crores and up to Rs. 14.86 Crores **(15 marks)**
4. Value of single completed contract above Rs. 14.86 Crores **(20 marks)**

Note: In event of submission of multiple Experience Certificates, the highest value certificate shall be considered for evaluation as above.

C. Number of years in business in similar type of work (Marks-20)

1. Equal to or Above 7 years and up to 10 years **(10 marks)**
2. Above 10 years and up to 15 years **(12 marks)**
3. Above 15 years **(20 marks)**

D. Number of qualified personnel on roll as specified above (Marks-20)

1. Qualified Personnel between 230 and 300 **(10 marks)**
2. Qualified Personnel between 301 and 500 **(12 marks)**
3. Qualified Personnel between 501 and 700 **(15 marks)**
4. Qualified Personnel above 700 **(20 marks)**

3.3 Marks for S.No. E and F in above table will be awarded based on the bidder's submission and presentation.

Note: Bids of technical score less than the minimum mandatory score of **50 Marks out of 100 Marks** shall be rejected and shall not be considered for opening of **Financial Bid**.

3.4 Stage-II. Financial evaluation of proposals: (Maximum Marks=100) (Weightage 30%)

The second stage the financial evaluation will be carried out based on the "Overhead and Admin Charges" quoted by the agency for Schedule-A and Schedule-B and "% quote" for Schedule-C quoted by the agency. The authority will determine whether in the financial proposals are complete, unqualified and unconditional. The cost indicated in the financial proposals shall be deemed as final and reflecting the total cost of services. Omission or mistake in calculation of obligator payments such as ESI, PF, HRA, and LWF etc. will be disqualified. The Financial Evaluation carries weightage of **30%**. **Financial score** shall be ranked as per the score achieved by them from lowest to highest financial score (Maximum marks).

3.5 Illustration for Financial Evaluation

Financial Evaluation will be done as per following.

Suppose there are four bidders A, B, C & D, & they have quoted in financial bid as under:

The bidder should quote the "Overhead and Admin Charges" for Schedule-A and Schedule-B rates and quote "+ Above"/ "- Below"/ "At Par" for Schedule-C in Financial Bid as described in Section-9: Financial Bid.

Total (Gross) Quoted Amount (excluding 18% GST) shall be calculated.

The evaluation of score shall be as under: -

- i. Price quoted by B is the lowest, he will get full 100 marks
- ii. $A = X2/X1 \times 100$

3.7 Stage-III. Combined Technical and final evaluation:

Final score shall be calculated as under:

Technical Bid and Financial Bid. $FS = (TS \times TW) + (FS \times FW)$

FS = Final Score

TS = Technical Score

TW = Technical Weightage (70%)

FS = Financial Score

FW = Financial Weightage (30%)

3.8 The agency will be finally ranked as per Combined and final weighted score & the agency which scores highest marks shall be proposed for award of the work.

3.9 In the event the final scores are same, the bidder securing the highest financial score will be adjudicated as the Successful Bidder for award of the contract.

3.10 The bidder has to submit valid certificate of registration or documentary evidence for number of years in business in similar type of work.

3.11 The bidder has to submit the valid certificate from the employer/ copy of LOA/ BOQ/ PF Registration or PF Challan stating the number of qualified personnel engaged by the bidder as on the last day of the month, previous to which the latest bid due date falls.
